Co-laboring in the Lord's Ministry Luke 5:18-20



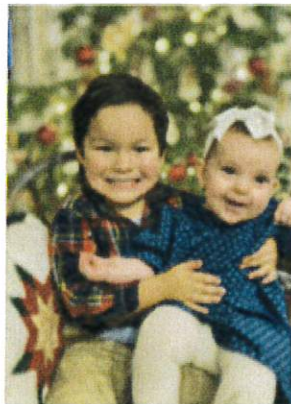
Christmas Greetings!

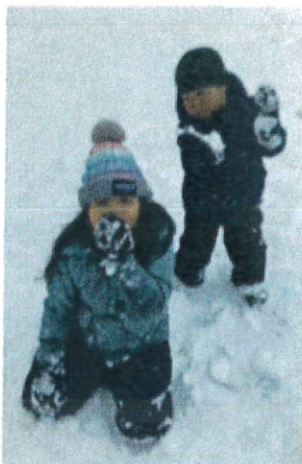
