Fifty-five years seems like a long time in some ways, and in others, it seems like only a few minutes ago. March 8, 1971, is one of those dates I remember as vividly as if it were yesterday. We were building a road in Quang Nam Province, South Vietnam. Before any construction could take place, the area had to be cleared of landmines and mortar rounds that had failed to detonate. The sweep we walked that morning was tedious. Tall elephant grass made metal detectors impractical, so we had to move very slowly and deliberately. As careful as I was, I still detonated the mine that took my legs. I should have died, BUT GOD! God had a plan. I'm grateful for the past fifty-five years. GOD IS SO GOOD!

On March 8th, it was fitting for me to return to my hometown to preach. It was an honor to preach for Pastor Tim Reynolds at Mount Vernon Baptist Temple in Mount Vernon, Illinois. Tim's dad, Ron Reynolds, pastored this church for almost fifty years. When I pastored, our churches were only thirty minutes apart. Our Christian schools played each other in sports, and we enjoyed wonderful fellowship. I have precious memories from those days. **On this Sunday, nine came for salvation, and many more made decisions as well!**

Connie and I drove to Illinois to spend some time with her parents. We planned to drive back to Dallas and then fly to Atlanta for our next meeting, but because of our government's partial shutdown and the long airport wait times, we decided to drive to Atlanta instead. At one point, we sat on the interstate for over two hours without moving! We were able to enjoy some time with my sister Jennifer and my brother-in-law Danny.

On Sunday, March 15th, I had the opportunity to do something I had never done in all my years of ministry—I preached in a deaf church! The pastor, his wife, and most of the congregation were deaf. Attendance that morning was over 150, far above their usual crowd, which is around forty. I preached with a great interpreter but I almost made a huge mistake at the end of my message. I nearly asked everyone to bow their heads and close their eyes, as I usually do. But they were watching the interpreter, so they would not have been able to "hear" what I was saying! **We saw several come for salvation and others come for baptism and church membership.**

After church, we drove nearly twelve hours back to our home near Dallas. On Tuesday, I flew to North Carolina for a special men's meeting in Gaffney, South Carolina. Tim Lee Ministries board member Mike Yates picked me up in Charlotte and drove me to the event. About 150 men from the Broad River Baptist Association were present. **Five men called upon the name of Jesus for salvation! Glory to God!**

Our next event was near Lexington, South Carolina, at the 15th annual Hank Parker Shoot, which raises funds for our ministry and others. I was honored to speak Thursday evening. On Friday, Hank Parker spoke to a tent full of people, **and several made decisions for Christ!**

I flew back to Dallas on Friday evening, and Connie and I flew to Fort Myers, Florida on Saturday to be with Pastor Eric McConnell and the folks of Suncoast Baptist Church in Port Charlotte. It had been several years since I was last there. **The Lord blessed with ten coming for salvation!** Suncoast Baptist Church has supported this ministry monthly for thirty years and we are very grateful!
