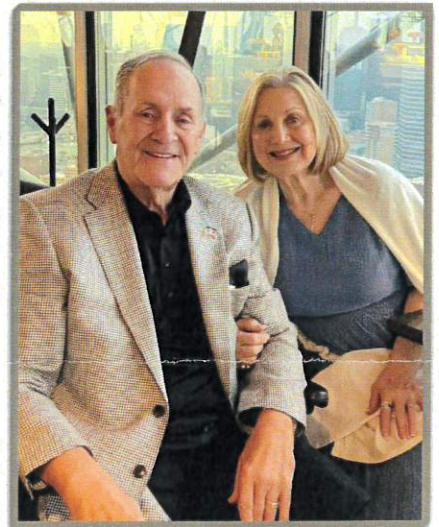

The following week, I flew back to Lynchburg to preach to about 250 military chaplains. I'm also privileged to serve on the board of Liberty Baptist Fellowship, headed up by Dr. Steve Keith. Liberty University is helping to train many of our military chaplains, and Liberty Baptist Fellowship helps to get them placed in the different branches of our military. This is a great opportunity and a serious obligation. Our chaplains are Bible believers and soul winners. I always look forward to this time with some of our chaplains.

Our hearts are full as we look back on all God has done. Thank you for praying for us and faithfully supporting this ministry. Every soul saved and every life changed is fruit that you have a part in. We thank God for you and do not take your partnership for granted.
