April and May have been two fruit-filled months in Sierra Leone. From Good Friday through the weeks that followed, the Lord has continued to open doors and bless the work with fruit. What you are reading below is not just a report but the return on your prayers and your investment in the Great Commission.

Angola Town Church Plant 🏠

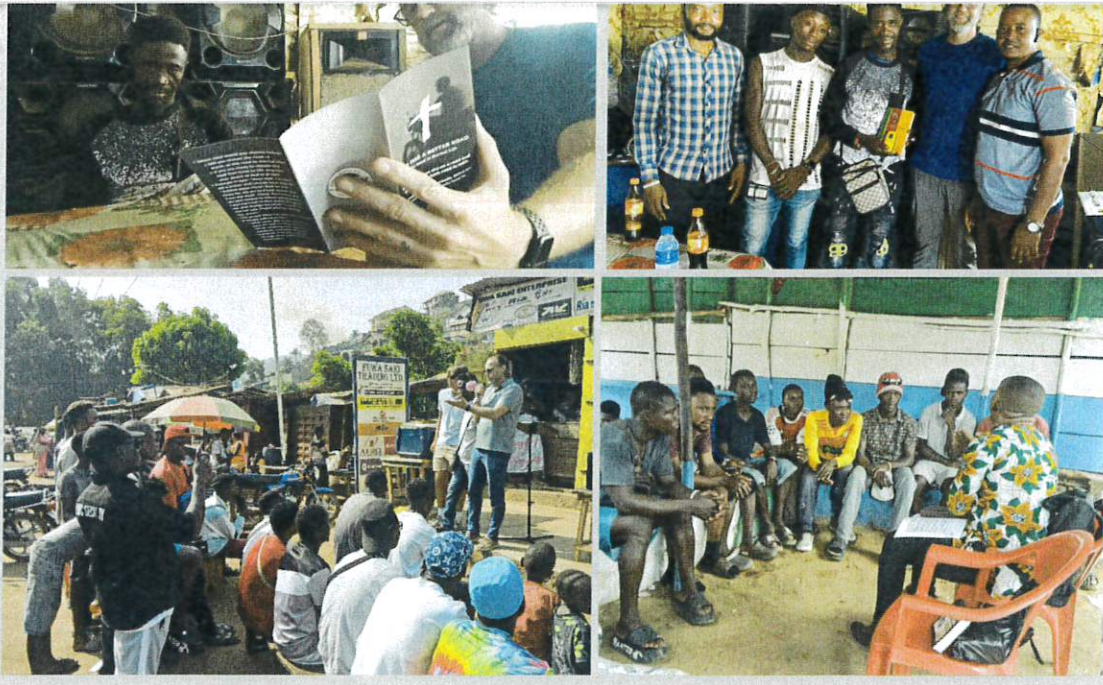
Good Friday marked a milestone for the Angola Town church plant as we hosted a Jesus Film outreach that led **28 people to trust Christ for salvation**. But the evening did not end there — we also held the **first baptism in this young congregation's history, with 9 believers following the Lord in obedience**. Watching brand-new disciples take that first step of public faith is a joy that never gets old. The church is averaging 37 in attendance and growing steadily. God is building something real here, and we are honored to come alongside it.



Okada Outreach Initiative 🚲

Easter Sunday marked the official launch of the Okada Outreach Initiative — our non-facility-dependent church-planting strategy that brings the Gospel directly into the spaces where people already live and gather. **The launch day alone produced 13 professions of faith**, and since then, weekly evangelism at the Okada park has continued to bear remarkable fruit. **To date, we have seen 78 professions of faith since the official launch.** What began as a conversation with a park chairman is now a growing movement of people who hear and respond to the Gospel week after week.

Alongside evangelism, a **weekly small-group Bible study and discipleship gathering has taken root right in the park, with an average of 40 active participants.** The seeds of a healthy, self-sustaining, non-facility-dependent local church are being planted in real time. We are praying toward that end with great expectation.



Discipleship & Pastoral Mentoring

Discipleship continues at the church level and through consistent one-on-one mentoring with the local pastors we partner closely with. This is slow, intentional, foundational work that develops leaders who will still be standing and faithfully shepherding long after we are gone. Sound doctrine, godly character, and Gospel clarity remain our focus.



Global Life University 🎓

The GLU students have finished the semester strong, and the growth we have observed this year has been tangible and encouraging. These are not just students completing assignments — they are men and women whose ministries and understanding of Scripture are visibly maturing. They are becoming the kind of leaders Sierra Leone desperately needs, and your partnership is directly fueling that development.

Kono District Village ☐

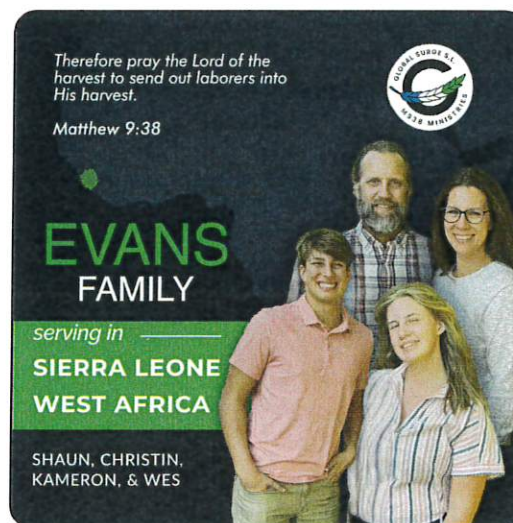
