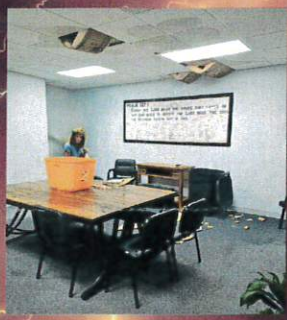

When we arrived at the center on the third morning, we walked in to see water pouring from sagging ceiling tiles and flooding multiple areas of the building. Our volunteers got right to work unplugging the roof drain, placing buckets and fans to catch dripping water and control the moisture, gathering debris, vacuuming standing water, and taking clothing home to be laundered.

That very next week, city storm drains overflowed, flooding our two front entrances! Due to these unforeseen circumstances, we will need to replace our roof, repair damaged plumbing, replace ruined furniture and possibly the floor covering.

Woman's Choice has:

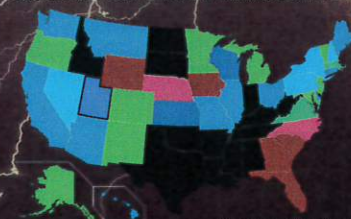
Performed **50** pregnancy tests & **44** ultrasounds.
